Type of District and Purpose:	Metropolitan district organized pursuant to C.R.S. 32-1-101 et seq. The District will serve to provide certain public improvements and operation and maintenance services for the use and benefit of property owners and residents within the boundaries of the District. The District has issued or will issue bonds that are paid by revenues produced from annual tax levies on the taxable property within the District. The buyer should investigate the financing plan of the District, proposed or existing mill levies of the District servicing such indebtedness, the potential for an increase in such mill levy and to determine if there are ongoing fees.
